IRRIGATION REPORT

DATE: May 27, 2019 PROJECT: Waterset Central

RE: Irrigation System

Routine maintenance was conducted throughout the month and any alarms detected by the Hunter IMMS software were addressed as quickly as possible. On May 9th the ET sensor stopped communicating with the A-controller, but communication was restored the next day after cycling the power. The filters at each point of connection were cleaned on multiple occasions due to the poor quality of the reclaimed water. The filter at the Amenity Center did not have the dual pressure gauges necessary to determine when the filter needs to be cleaned. These were installed the end of May and will make it much easier to determine when the filter needs cleaning. Next month, flow totals will be measured for each zone and flow monitoring will begin. After several significant rainfall events, all three controllers were converted from traditional schedules to ET based programming.

Between April 27th and May 27th, the ET sensor located at the intersection of Paseo-Al-Mar and Paradiso recorded 5.52" of ET and 4.29" of rain. There were four significant rainfall events of over 0.25", the greatest occurring on May 2nd when 1.63" of rain fell at the site. The ACC controllers were shut down for a total of 6 days to take advantage of what nature provided. The Tampa Bay area is presently experiencing unusually dry and windy conditions. This is helping keep the humidity down, but ET is on the rise. It is also affecting the effectiveness of the irrigation system, causing more water to be blown onto streets, sidewalks and other non-irrigated areas. We are taking steps to increase the irrigation duration and/or frequency when feasible and manually irrigating zones when necessary, but there may be issues with hot spots until the winds calm down and we get some badly needed rain.

Waterset North & Central CDDs

1) 2019 – 2020 Staffing Budgets – Castle Group

Waterset North CDD

- 2) Vending Machine Lakeside (Sam's Proposal): The machine below is ADA compliant and holds both drinks and snack. Sam's Club offers a rebate program with fill for the machine that can negate much of the initial cost of the machine. If added, the cafe team could restock the machine, as needed, and the profit generated could help offset operational losses the board is concerned about with The Landing Cafe, moving us closer towards profitability.
- 3) Playground Mulch Proposals (Ratification if approved between meetings)
- 4) Onsight Street Sign Proposal (Ratification if approved between meetings)
- 5) WiFi Proposal- Updated Proposal from Frontier

ADMINISTRATIVE

- Four new team members have joined out staff in the month of May. Katelyn started as a full-time member of the Resident Services team. Sarah joined the Café team as a part-time member.
 Additionally, Doug and Kevin have joined our team as pool monitors, bringing our pool monitor staff to four members just in time for the start of the summer pool season.
- 2) Community Director Barry Mazzoni and Regional Director Marilyn submitted staffing recommendations for consideration for the North & Central CDD 2019-2020 budgets. A great deal of time, effort and consideration has been placed into the staffing plans to ensure that our staffing recommendations ensure meet the service expectations of Waterset's residents and your needs with the growth and expansion of the community.
- 3) Resident Services received a new shipment of lanyards for the amenity cards and reordered another box of amenity cards this week.
- 4) The insurance carrier agent for Waterset Central visited the Waterset Club to look at the slide. The insurance carrier states that it is up to the manufacturer of the slide whether life jackets could be used for children under 44 inches, allowing them to use the slide. We are waiting to receive their report.

- 5) Regional Director Marilyn Nieves is working on a schedule of systems training days for our Administrators at a nearby community. When completed, the training should enhance the resident experience at the office.
- 6) The Waterset HOA Board of Directors approved Charters for the formation of the following committees:
 - a) <u>Design Review Committee</u>- This committee will review architectural change applications submitted by owners and will have the opportunity to make recommendations to the Design Guidelines adopted by the HOA Board.
 - b) <u>Compliance Committee</u> which will provide hearings for those owners that have not corrected violations noted on their property.
 - c) <u>Social Committee</u>: This committee with partner with management to provide fun, engaging and entertaining activities for the enjoyment of all Waterset residents.
 - d) <u>Service Area Committee</u>: This committee will be formed from residents that live in the Villas, Townhomes and 30 ft Lots and receive lawn maintenance and other services from the Waterset HOA. The committee will review services and make recommendations to the Board regarding the execution and disposition of these services.

We have already received very positive feedback on the formation of these committees and Resident Services is currently taking applications from those residents that are interested in participating.

MAINTENANCE

- 1) Resident Services sent out a reminder to residents regarding the use of swim diapers following two incidents that forced the closure of the Resort Pool in the last three weeks.
- 2) We contacted Accurate Electronics to service the DSX (Amenity Card) system. The system was showing a communication error. The error was corrected.
- 3) Maintenance pressure cleaned the furniture and areas at the North pool, The Splash pad and the Resort and Lap Pools at the Waterset Club, removed the liners from all trash cans and cleaned them deodorizer, transferred the cleaning supplies at the Waterset Club to the outside storage area, moved the records inside, cleaned debris from the ponds and fixed a screen at the Pavilion
- 4) There has been an increase in dumping around Waterset. Maintenance has collected furniture, car parts and other large items in April. Community Director contacted the Landfill and was told it will \$500 to setup an account. Community Director authorized the use of Mighty Junk Truck to remove the materials at a cost of \$225, which will be split between the two CDDs.
- 5) Aquatic Systems reported issues with several ponds. They will be sending proposals over to Rizzetta for the North & Central Boards to review.
- 6) Payne Air Conditioning was on property this week. They replaced the damaged pan in the 2nd unit of the Waterset Club's air conditioning system. They recommended going forward that the maintenance contract team for these A/C units does not use pleated filters. These filters cause the unit to work harder than necessary.
- 7) Technicians have been out to review the pump for the smaller water slide. It was communicated that the infuser was damaged, and the pump needed to be replaced. The work was completed and the Slide is operational.
- 8) Suncoast Pools technicians came out this week to adjust the flow rate of the Splash pad.

- 9) A new supply of Dog bags for the Dog Stations were ordered from dogpoopbags.com. Cleaning and restroom supplies were restocked from Sam's Club. A resupply or Gym wipes were order from 2XL Corporation.
- 10) Squeegee Squad was at The Landing on May 20th to clean the inside and outside of the windows.
- 11) The Men's restroom at Lakeside was vandalized. Photos of how it was found on the morning of Monday, May 20th were included in the May 24th weekly report. Maintenance was able to restore the paper dispensers and get them back in working order.
- 12) Community Director authorized addition trapping for rodents at the Waterset Club after an inspection by Nvirotect confirmed activity within the building.
- 13) Maintenance repaired a wipe dispenser in the Waterset Club Fitness Center that was pulled off the wall by a resident.
- 14) Resident Services ordered a replacement stretch band and exercise ball for The Waterset Club Fitness Center. The other ones were broken by users.
- 15) Maintenance has removed the weed barrier that was sticking up at the Splash Pad.

OPEN PROJECTS & MAINTENANCE ITEMS AS OF 5/27/19:

Waterset North CDD

- a) We have submitted the signed proposal to WCP to replace the missing flashing at lakeside, repair the drywall damage to the ceiling of the women's restroom and reinstall the siding on the Landing that came off during a recent storm.
- b) We have obtained an updated proposal from On-site regarding missing street signs and provided it to Rizzetta and North CDD Chair for approval.
- c) The WiFi at the Landing is not functioning normally. We have obtained another proposal from Frontier to address the system.
- d) The weed barrier under the teeter totter equipment was removed as it was sticking up at the lakeside Playground. We are in the process f obtaining proposals for mulch for Artisan, the Lakeside playground and the Landing Playground. The Waterset Club playground was inspected and does not require mulch at this time.
- e) The control board for the Dog park is not working. Accurate Electronics is submitting a proposal to replace it.
- f) There are a few dog signs that require replacement. With staffing limits in place, we plan to address as time allows and as high priority projects are completed.
- g) The fireplace screens need painting and/or replacement. With staffing limits in place, we plan to address as time allows and as high priority projects are completed.

Waterset Central CDD

- a) Resident Services has communicated warranty issues with one kitchen drawer, the locks on the Entertainment cabinets, depth marker on the Lap Pool, the lock of the Gathering Room Closet, the ceiling fans in the patio area and multiple sections of the soffit.
- b) Community Director Barry Mazzoni approved rodent trapping by Nvirotect for the Waterset Club due to an increase in activity in the Gathering Room and the offices.

LANDSCAPING

- Community Director met with Mike from LMP this week to review a few issues reported by owners.
- Community Director noted members of LMP smoking on CDD property, disposing of cigarette butts in landscaping. This was communicated to the supervisor. Supervisor states they will address it.
- 3) LMP completed additional palm training at the Waterset Club the week of May 24th.

SECURITY

1) Community Director drafted and sent a Post Order and Procedure Manual for G4S Security to Rizzetta and G4S. Previously, G4S communicated they do not have one on file for Waterset.

MEETINGS AND EVENTS

- 1) The Waterset HOA hosted its Mother's Day crafty activity in the Gathering Room on Saturday, May 4th from 10am to Noon.
- 2) The Landing Cafe hosted Wine Down on Friday, May 17th. There was live music, food trucks and drink specials for residents to enjoy.
- 3) The Waterset HOA will be hosting a Father's Day craft activity on Saturday, June 8th from 10am to Noon.
- 4) Newland will be hosting their summer story time event at The Landing. Please see the May/ June issue of the Waterset Wave for further details.
- 5) The Coffee with Castle event was held Thursday, May 23rd. About twenty residents were in attendance. North CDD board member Michael Ball and Community Resource officer Deputy Billy Nixon from the HCSO were in attendance and answered a variety of questions asked during the event.
- 6) Partnering with the Newland Marketing team, Resident Services sent out email blast reminders to residents for National Trails Day on Saturday, June 1st.

Resignation:

On Thursday, May 16th 2019, I tendered my resignation as Community Director of Waterset to the Castle Group. I would like to take a moment to express my appreciation the to the Waterset residents, the HOA Board and members of both CDD Boards for their partnership and feedback since I arrived on property in July 2018. Looking back, we were able to complete a great number of outstanding maintenance projects and install many new and updated processes together. Though the long commute from home and staffing challenges were difficult over the past ten months, I am extremely proud of my team's results and efforts. Building on what has been accomplished and established, I am confident that the next Community Director will be able to take Resident Services at Waterset to even greater heights.

Average kWh per day – The average amount of electricity purchased

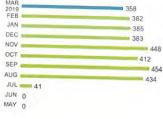

Understanding Your Electric Charges

Average kWh per day - The average amount of electricity purchased per day.

Basic Service Charge - A fixed monthly amount to cover the cost of providing service to your location.

Bright Choices_{sm} - The number of light fixtures and/or poles leased from Tampa Electric, and associated fees and charges.

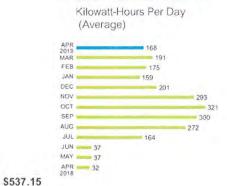

Visit Overview:

The purpose of the visit on the above referenced date was to allow our team to gain a better understanding of the Waterset Central Community Development District which consists of approximately 406 acres. The number of ponds and housing units is increasing as the district is not fully built out at this time. District owned amenities include a clubhouse, resort and lap pool, water slide, fitness center, as well as tennis, pickleball, basketball, and volleyball courts. While on site, we had the opportunity to review the insured property schedule and made note any necessary updates. An updated schedule will be provided by your Account Manager for your review and acceptance.

The visit also allowed us to support the district's loss control efforts by identifying any hazards that could lead to accidents and claims and discuss recommendations to remediate any loss producing conditions. Those recommendations are included in this letter. While we did not have the opportunity to observe all areas owned and/or maintained by the district, we feel that the areas we were able to observe are representative of the general condition of the property.

Loss Control Observations:

Strengths:

- Restroom floors demonstrate good slip resistance. Wet floor signage is used when appropriate.
 (Figure A)
- Slide rules signage is in place and visible before entering the slide, as well as while on the slide tower. The slide is only open when a monitor is in place. (Figure B)
- Fire suppression equipment inspections are up to date. (Figure C)
- CCTV camera system monitors amenity areas. (Figure D)



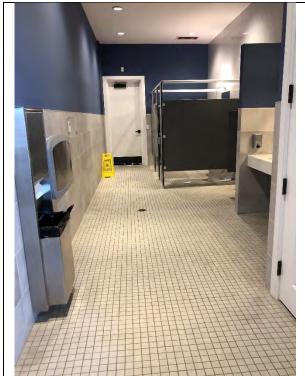

Recommendations:

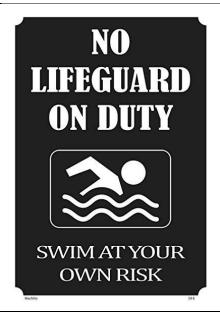
Rec. 01 Pond Signage – Consider adding signage to ponds that are adjacent to areas with high
pedestrian traffic including sidewalks and trails. Signage should prohibit swimming, and warn of
wildlife in the area such as alligators and snakes. Signage would be a prudent addition near the
playground. Sample signage is included below. Signage can remind residents that a catch and
release policy is in place if fishing is allowed.





• Rec. 02 Lifeguard Signage – The current pool rules signage does not have any language indicating that the pool is "swim at your own risk" nor that there is no lifeguard on duty. It is important to inform residents of these conditions so that they may take the necessary precautions when entering the pool area and using the pool. This may be accomplished by adding signs similar to the example included in the bottom right photo in the pool area and at all pool entry gates. A revision of the existing signs to include this language should also be considered.







Rec. 03 Playground Signage – Signage and/or labels should be posted in all playground areas or
on the equipment to provide guidance as to the age appropriateness of playground equipment.
This helps in keeping children from using equipment not designed by the manufacturer for their
age, size, and ability. Signage should also remind parents and guardians that children should be
supervised at all times and that surfaces may be hot. Although the label pictured below includes
some of this information, it is not as resilient as signage. The sign example included below is the
same sign used at Waterset North.



WARNING

Installation over a hard surface such as concrete, asphalt, or packed earth may result in serious injury or death from falls.

Drawstrings have entangled on slides and other playground equipment causing strangulation, REMOVE helmets, drawstrings, scarves and other accessories around the neck prior to playing on the playground.

> Surfacing and playsurfaces may become HOT and cause burns. Check for hot surfaces prior to playing on the playground.

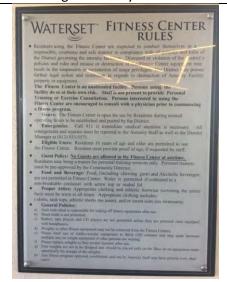

• Rec. 04 Fitness Center Rules – At this time, the rules for the Waterset Central fitness center are not posted in or near the fitness center. Posting a rules sign helps to remind residents of the policies the district has put in place, including eligibility requirements. The photo at the bottom right shows the rules posted at Waterset North, which appear to be consistent with Waterset Central's policies. Identify a location in or near the entrance of the fitness center to post the rules so that they are visible to all residents/guests who may consider using the facility.





• Rec. 05 Floor Mats – Mats and entry and exit points are a great best practice in reducing the likelihood of slips and falls, especially in inclement weather. As mats age and wear, the edges may become warped and frayed, creating a trip hazard. Develop a procedure to inspect mats and replace them as needed. Keeping an inventory of spare mats helps to facilitate this process. The mat pictured below is located in front of the fitness center entrance.





• Rec. 06 Pool Life Safety Equipment – Quick and easy access to life safety equipment is critical in emergency situations. The life ring and hook pictured below is accessible, but it is obstructed by the growing landscape in front of it. Consider relocating the posts and equipment so that it is not obstructed by the landscaping. One option may be to move one of the posts so that is in front of the landscape area instead of behind it.
